Education Provider Information

About CSF: Children's Scholarship Fund (CSF) is a 501 (c)(3) organization founded in 1998 by Ted Forstmann and John Walton to expand educational opportunity for all children. Since its inception, CSF has awarded scholarships worth \$1.15 billion dollars to 217,434 deserving children and their families so they can benefit from an education that best meets their needs, regardless of their ability to pay or where they live.

How will families use CSF homeschool scholarships to pay for educational expenses?

Digital Wallet: Families will access CSF funds and make payments for services and materials through ClassWallet, a digital wallet and payment platform, with oversight by CSF. To receive payment from a CSF homeschool family, education providers must meet the requirements explained below.

What do education providers have to do to get paid through the CSF homeschool scholarship program?

Register as an Education Provider: In order to receive payment from CSF, education service providers are required to complete the following steps:

Step 1. Complete the registration [form here](#), including uploading your credentials.

Step 2. After your application is approved by CSF, you will receive an email with a link to the ClassWallet website and the required next steps. Follow the instructions in that email to set up your ClassWallet account. ClassWallet transactions are subject to a 2.5% processing fee, which is the responsibility of the education service provider.
